**Intent of Gateway Airport to request FAA approval to amend Passenger Facility Charges
Impose and Use Authority**

COMMENT PERIOD CORRECTED TO END FEBRUARY 11, 2019

The Phoenix-Mesa Gateway Airport Authority intends to file amendments with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to increase the PFC#5 Impose Authority and increase the PFC#6 Use Authority to complete the Northeast Area Channel Design and Construction (aka Ellsworth Channel Relocation) and to amend the financing plan.

As required under Section 158.37(b), PMGAA is hereby providing written notice to the public of its intent to amend its Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) Program as follows:

- 17-05-C-00-IWA (PFC#5) Increase the approved PFC Impose authority by more than 25%; materially alter the scope of approved project financing plan.
- 18-06-U-00-IWA (PFC#6) Increase the approved PFC Use authority by more than 25%; materially alter the scope of approved project financing plan.

The amendments allow for increased estimated costs and a change in the proposed financing method for the project. At the time of the original PFC applications, the Ellsworth Channel Relocation project anticipated local municipal funding totaling \$4 million which is no longer available to the project. In addition, the cost estimate has risen by \$2 million due to market conditions. The total project cost will now total \$11 million and will be financed all with PFC funds which extends the collection authority for approximately two additional years.
