Subject: Safe Driving Practices

Briefing:

AOA/Non-Movement Area Drivers and Aircraft Operators:

In the past 12 months, there have been several vehicle incidents and reports at the airport, leading to personnel injuries, property damage, and violations in the movement area.

The operations of vehicles and aircraft on the Tango Apron have seen an increase in recent months. To minimize risks while operating vehicles, personnel are required to adhere to safe driving practices.

Safe Driving

Whether operating in the movement area, on an apron, the perimeter road, or the marked service road, practice the following:

1. Aircraft have the right away.
2. Slow down when operating in unfamiliar and high traffic areas.
3. Recognize existing hazards and operate the vehicle in the safest manner
4. Maintain safe operating speeds. Per Airport Rules & Regulations:
 - a. Aircraft apron or ramp area = 15mph
 - b. Around any aircraft = 5mph
5. Avoid distractions and maintain situational awareness.



Red: Triturator site vehicle traffic route.

Stop prior to exiting the triturator site and look for aircraft and vehicle traffic in the area.

Green: Fuel Farm vehicle traffic route.

Stop after exiting the fuel farm, wait for gate to close, and look for aircraft and vehicle traffic in the area.
