**Phoenix Mesa Gateway (IWA)
Aviation Activity Forecast Approval**

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has reviewed the aviation forecast for the Phoenix Mesa Gateway Airport (IWA) dated November 28, 2018. The FAA approves both this forecast and the use of C-III for the existing and D-V for the future critical design aircrafts.

The forecast was developed using current data, appropriate methodologies, and is within the acceptable range for TAF tolerance and therefore is approved for planning purposes, to include Airport Layout Plan development at IWA. It is important to note that the approval of this forecast doesn't guarantee funding for large scale capital improvements as future projects will need to be justified by current activity levels at the time the projects are proposed for implementation.
